




#### Laikaka Incubator Development Model - Planning (2000)

- It includes management, marketing, information systems and finance.




## Projected approaches of institution towards encouraging students for entrepreneurship

## Latest examples A/c Cooler




- Just 2 litres water for entire day

- For the large enhancement in business Paytm borrowed 300 Cr from ICICI Bank as working capital in March 2016.
